


Club Meeting 25th August 2014


In the interests of keeping members better informed about club activities, board minutes in future will contain much more club information, together with the 'Bulletin' the aim is to keep members better informed.

Busy Bees are being organised so that we can keep our premises and our equipment respectable, please make yourself available by adding to the list being sent around.





Guest Speaker: City of Kwinana Mayor Carol Adams

Introduced by PP Genevieve Carr.

Mayor Carol came along tonight to bring club members up to date with Local Government Reform.

The State Government has announced plans for widespread changes to local government arrangements in metropolitan Perth.

The plans, which include reducing the number of local governments from 1 July 2015, are aimed at building a stronger, more effective and financially secure local government sector.

Three proposals are now before government,

The Ministers Proposal, The LGAB Proposal and the New Cockburn Proposal.

The Ministers Proposal is still clearly the best outcome for the Kwinana community and the broader south-metro region. It provides an equitable split of rate base and population, producing local governments of optimal size and sustainability. Kwinana, Fremantle and Melville will work individually to optimise local service delivery but collaborate to provide regional economies of scale and scope and service equalisation across the region.

The City of Kwinana has done a massive amount of work towards 'Reform Program Planning' incorporating a 'Vision' to 2015/2020

Reform Program Priorities:

- 1. Achieve stability in the transformed entity.
- 2. Capture key benefits.
- 3. Transform for future service delivery.

Submissions closed in August, Board will make a recommendation to Minister. The Minister will announce the government's decision late September.

The Governor will then order a 'Boundary Adjustment'

The Community will request 'A Poll' and the 'Community plan starts'

Reform Budget - Cockburn and Kwinana.

The 'Community Poll' to take place in December 2014

The Governor is expected to order 'Amalgamation' in January 2015.

July 2015 the Amalgamation or Boundary Change in effect.

Commissioners appointed (Amalgamation)
Both Councils abolished (Amalgamation)
Interim CEO appointed by commissioners (Amalgamation)
Lead CEO and Council Members remain (Boundary Change)

Mayor Carol and your council are working hard to obtain the best outcome for Kwinana.
