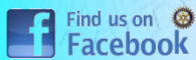

After our planned Sunday lunch date at Lavoro's was cancelled in October, Stephen has again booked for 30 at Lavoro's for Sunday 11th December for lunch

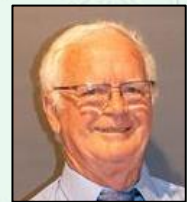

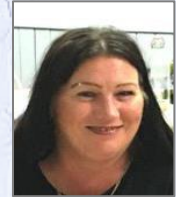

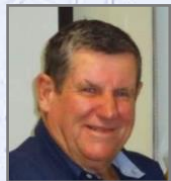

Five change-makers in the Eastern Mediterranean's polio eradication programme – the GPEI stands tall on the foundation of million of women's efforts and voices. [More](#).

Pakistan: one positive environmental sample

Mozambique: one WPV1 case and five cVDPV1 cases

Botswana: one cVDPV2 environmental sample

Central African Republic: one cVDPV2 environmental sample

DR Congo: seven cVDPV1 cases and three cVDPV2 cases

Madagascar: two cVDPV1 cases

Nigeria: one cVDPV2 case

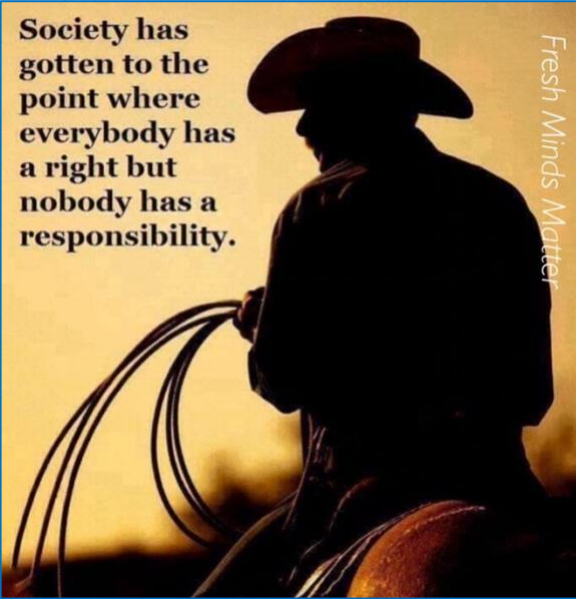

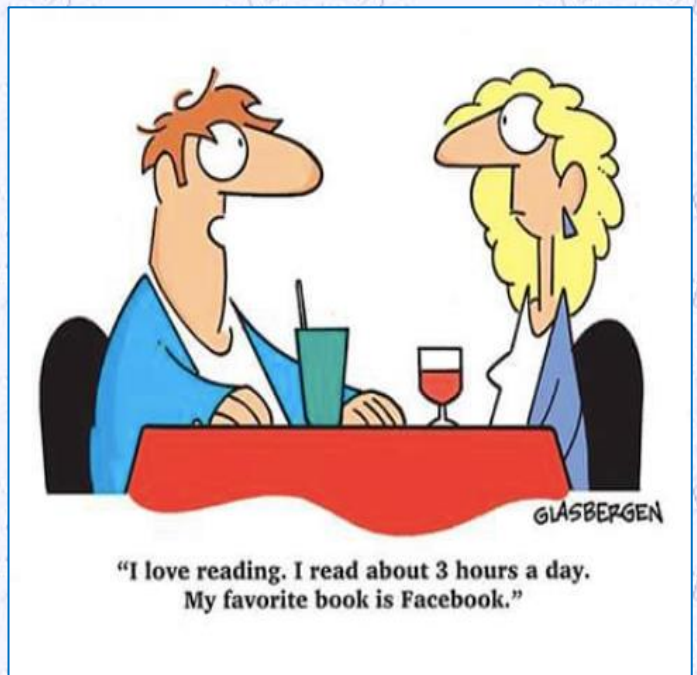
