



Mission

World Polio Day, 24 October, is an ideal time to raise public awareness of the ravages of polio and garner support for eradication efforts.

October 24, marks the birth of Jonas Salk who as the leader of the team that invented a polio vaccine in 1955.

In 1988 Albert Sabin developed an oral polio vaccine. This is what we're using today. It has reduced polio worldwide by 99%.




The next Wellard Village Markets will be next held on Sunday 9th November.

Group Heat of the 4 Way Test Speaking Competition



Held Monday 27th October at Rotary Club of Kwinana

What is the Four Way Test?

The Four-Way Test was conceived in 1932 at the height of the Great Depression by Herbert J Taylor, a Chicago Rotarian who later became President of Rotary International during its 50th Anniversary Year (1954/55). In 1932 he joined a company which was on the verge of bankruptcy, with a view of reviving the troubled firm. Rotarian Taylor single-mindedly searched for a yardstick of ethics that the workers at his company could use.

He hit on a 24 word statement which asked four questions and which became known as the Four-Way Test of the things we think, say or do.

The four questions were:

- 1. Is it the TRUTH?
- 2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
- 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

As a result of his workers applying this test to everything they thought, said or did, a climate of trust and goodwill developed amongst dealers, customers and employees which changed the business prospects of the company.

In 1943, Rotary International adopted the Four-Way Test as parts of its Vocational Service program. Today it is considered to be a vital element in all avenues of Rotary Service.

Emmanuel is in Year 10 at CBC Fremantle. His interests include music, sports, philosophy and psychology.



Rotary helped put polio eradication on center stage on the day best known for rallying support to finish the job – World Polio Day, 24 October.



A special Livestream presentation – World Polio Day: Making History – showcased the progress of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative. Co-hosted by Rotary and the Northwestern University Center for Global Health, the 60-minute program took place before a live audience at the John Hughes Auditorium on Northwestern's Chicago campus and streamed online to viewers worldwide.

RI President Ron Burton kicked off the event by noting that Rotary began immunizing millions of children against polio in the 1970s, first in the Philippines and then in other high-risk countries.

"Polio rates in those countries plummeted," Burton said. "As a result, in 1988, Rotary, the World Health Organization [WHO], UNICEF, and the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention came together to launch the Global Polio Eradication Initiative. More recently, the initiative has benefited from the tremendous

support of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation It is so very important to finish the job."
