Is your club using the correct Rotary branding?

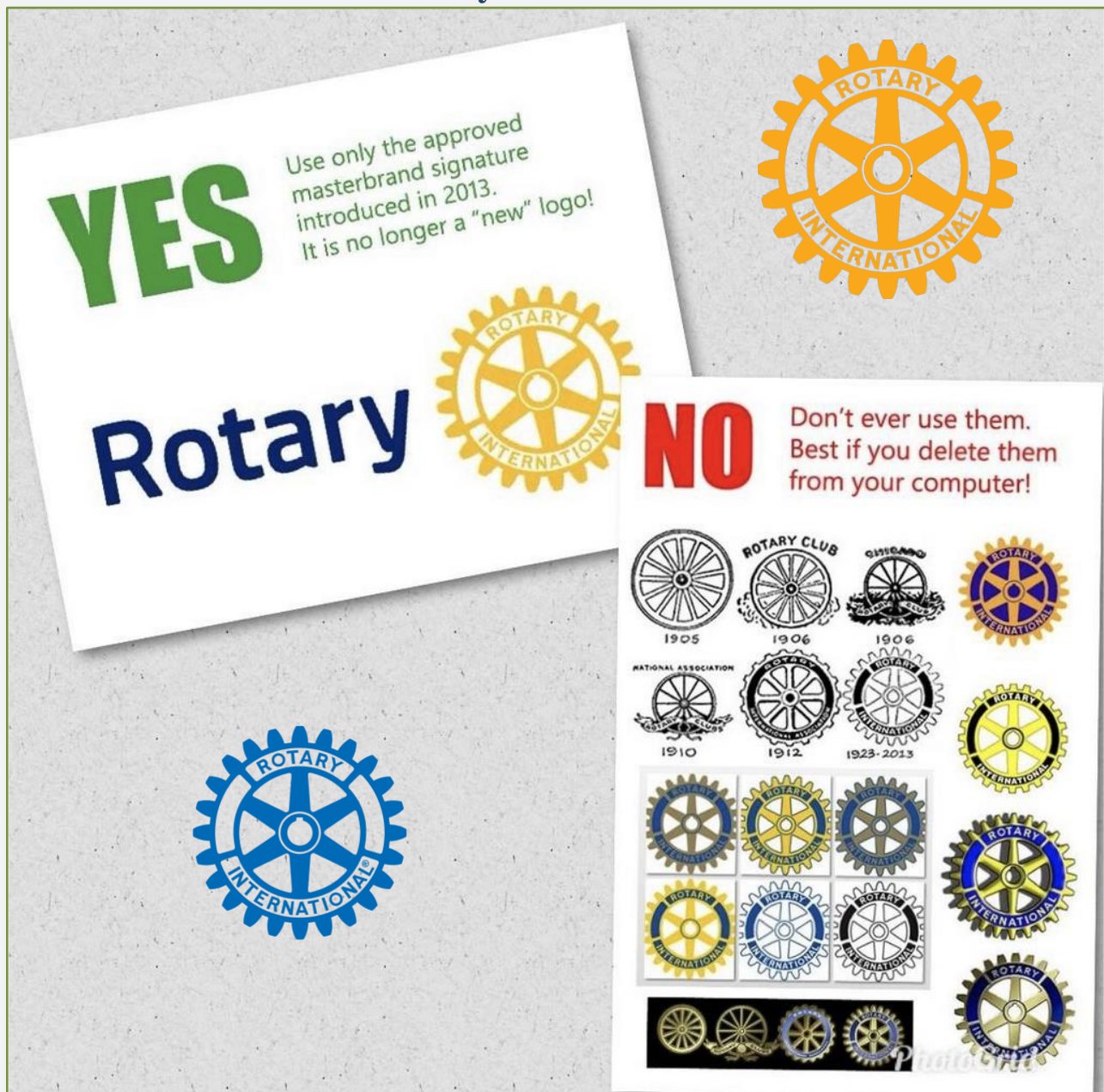
Having a consistent brand image is important to all organisations, Rotary is no exception.
