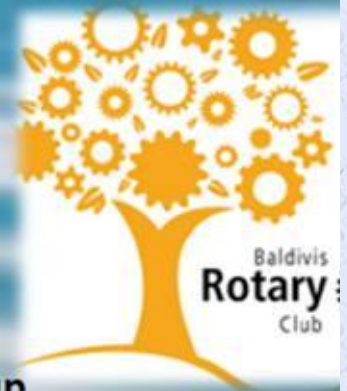

Citizen of the Year – Senior Max Bird ***Weekend Courier 30 January 2018***

Mr Bird has been a member of the local Rotary Club for 19 years, being president twice and has committed his time to many different community projects over the years.

Mr Bird is the spearhead of the Rotary Timor project that delivers clean drinking water to remote villages. He has raised \$200,000 towards this project so far and installed wells in four remote villages. Attendance of girls in the local schools improved dramatically, as these girls previously walked long distances to access water for the family before they could attend school.

Mr Bird is a key player in the Rotary Bread Run, which supplies bread for school breakfast clubs in the area and is a Director of the new Kwinana Branch of the Bendigo Branch.

February 2018: Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution Month

Sixty million people are displaced by armed conflict or persecution. Ninety percent of armed-conflict casualties are civilians, half of them children. Through service projects, fellowships and other Rotary-sponsored campaigns, Rotarians train adults and young leaders to prevent and mediate conflict and aid refugees who have fled dangerous areas.

Rotarians also pursue projects to address the underlying structural causes of conflict, including poverty, inequality, ethnic tensions, lack of access to education and unequal distribution of resources. Each year, up to 100 Rotary Peace Fellows are selected to attend Rotary Peace Centers to participate in master's degree programs at one of its partner universities. Fellows study subjects related to the root causes of conflict and explore innovative solutions that address real-world needs.

The Rotary Foundation promotes the practice of peace and conflict prevention/resolution by:

- Strengthening local peace efforts
- Training local leaders to prevent and mediate conflict
- Supporting long-term peace building in areas affected by conflict.
- Assisting vulnerable populations affected by conflict, particularly children and youth
- Supporting studies related to peace and conflict resolution.
