- The "Show and Shine" car event is happening. The website and email address are now up and running. At present we have 300 cars registered for show!!! We now need the public to come along and see the event, hence would encourage everyone to spread the word amongst family and friends via social media and/or other forms of communication. Registration forms are available – can be done either online (preferred) or via hard copy form. On Sunday 19 February we will need to start at 7am at the Motorplex to control parking and entry; have appointed 11 marshals for the gate. Each marshal will have hard copy registration sheets available for those not registered online. The entry fee for pensioners will be \$5 (need to show pension card). Gates will be open from 8am – 10am exhibitors to enter, and the public will be admitted from 10am – 4pm. Exhibitors may leave early under controlled conditions. The food van will be present as our office, and we will communicate with people on the grounds via two-way radio. John and Chris Iriks will look after market stalls – so far we have 19 stalls confirmed. High visibility vests and wide-brimmed hats will be provided. 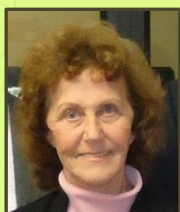
