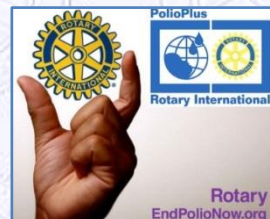

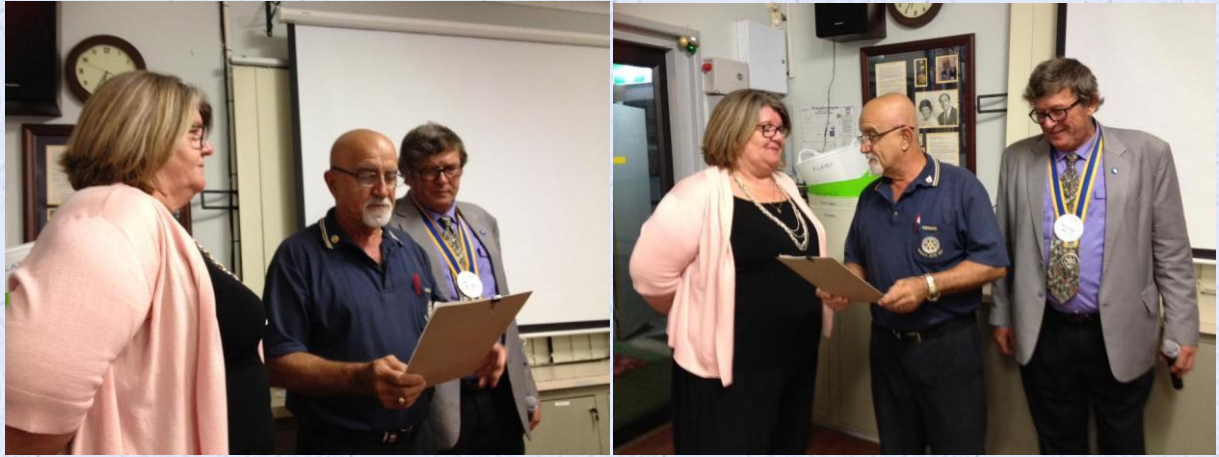

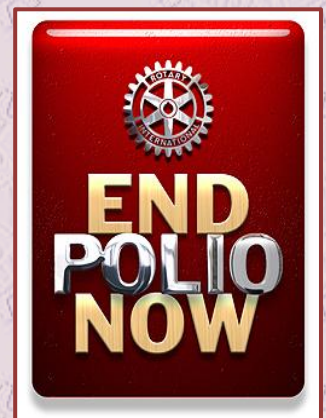

AG Peter Warren

At short notice AG Peter Warren (who had initially arrived as a visitor!) agreed to act as guest speaker following the non-attendance of our previously scheduled speaker. Peter indicated his pleasure at being present at our club, and gave mention of how he has appreciated being kept informed of our club activities through the bulletin and social media.

Peter attended the recent District Conference at Margaret River, where he noted the good attendance from the Kwinana club and enjoyed seeing PP Max Bird receive the special *Service Above Self* award. Two weeks ago Peter attended the President-Elect training session, and was pleased to see our President-Elect Stephen Castelli being so enthusiastic about his upcoming role. District Assembly is scheduled for this Sunday 6 May. Peter extended a special welcome to Diane Brown following her induction into our club, and also gave mention of how impressed he was to hear of Mike Nella and Steve Castelli's upcoming trip to Indonesia to work on the next stage of the school.

Late last year Peter gave us an extensive account of his work with Mukti Mission, a charity based in India which strives to support vulnerable women and children. This week Peter gave us a brief update on Mukti. At present there are approximately 500 people on the site in India, of which 200-300 are girls, and the remaining numbers are comprised of other women and staff. The facility has a kindergarten, primary school and secondary school. In addition there are shops and offices which have been built through the sponsorship of certain US businesses. The word "Mukti" means "freedom" – a highly appropriate name given the goals of this organization. Peter was proud to report that there continue to be many positive stories arising from the work of Mukti Mission. Further information is available at www.mukti.org.au.
