Information for Artists

Exhibition

Exhibits, wherever possible, will be suitably displayed in the Promotions Court at Westfield Booragoon for public viewing, from Monday 8 June to Sunday 14 June during shopping hours. See map at the end of the document for location.

Details

Paintings in oils, watercolours, pastels, mosaics, or other suitable painting media will be accepted. **AI-generated art, digital art, and photography are not eligible for this exhibition.**

Rewards

No prizes are awarded.

The exhibition provides artists with:

- exposure to thousands of visitors at Westfield Booragoon
- the opportunity to sell work directly to the public
- potential commission enquiries

Entry

Entries open **Monday 27 April** 9am (AWST)

Entries Close Saturday 23 May 5pm (AWST)

Entry fees must be paid during online entry or included with the offline entry form.

Entry Fee

Entrants may submit up to **four individual paintings** for the exhibition.

- **Paired paintings** (e.g., diptychs) are counted as **two entries**.
- You may not submit more than **four total entries**, whether single works or pairs.
- A **non-refundable entry** fee of \$17.50 per painting applies.
- Each piece in a pair is charged individually.

Commission

A **25% commission** will be deducted from each sale. Artists will receive payment within approximately **2–3 weeks** after the exhibition closes. Proceeds from the entry fees and commission will offset exhibition costs and will aid the Applecross and Melville Rotary Clubs' Community Services.

Images

It is optional during entry to upload an image of the artwork. This may be used to promote the Art Show on social media platforms such as Facebook and Instagram.

Identification and Sale of Works

EVERY entry must be distinctly marked as follows:

ON THE BACK OF THE ARTWORK:

- Title of the painting
- Artist's name
- Artist's telephone number

ON A LABEL ATTACHED TO THE FRONT:

- Title
- Artist's Name
- Price in AU\$

If more than one item is entered, please ensure that this information is on the back and front of EACH ENTRY (including pairs). All entries must be for sale and remain on display at the discretion of the Director until the exhibition closes. The information booth will be attended daily to effect sales.

All entries must be submitted by the artist who created the work. Works may not be entered by galleries, agents, or representatives on behalf of an artist.

Size and Presentation

One artwork per artist may be up to **1000mm x 1000mm** including frame. All additional works must not exceed **700mm x 700mm** including frame. Entries will be displayed in the exhibition **space permitting**, but organisers will not be bound to exhibit all entries. Works must be **touch-dry and immediately ready to hang** (with either cord or wire fixing). **Screw eyes must be protected** to avoid damage to other entries.

Closing Date for Entry Forms

All entry forms must be received by **Saturday 23 May at 5pm (AWST)**. Entry forms received after this date may not be eligible for inclusion. Completed forms are to be emailed (only if payment by credit card), or sent with payment to:

Responsibility

The Rotary Clubs of Applecross and Melville will exercise care but will not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to, any works submitted. Artists should make their own insurance arrangements.

Receiving Day

All costs associated with delivering and collecting artworks are the responsibility of the entrant. All entries are to be delivered to the Western Mall entrance (Davy Street entry), Westfield Booragoon on **Sunday 7 June** between **6pm and 7pm**.

This is the only time exhibits can be received.

Removal Day

BUYERS

All **SOLD** artworks must be picked up by the buyer from Westfield Booragoon on **Sunday 14 June** between **1pm and 2pm**. **Valid receipts MUST be produced.**

ARTISTS

All **UNSOLD** artworks must be picked up from Westfield Booragoon on **Sunday 14 June** between **3pm and 4pm**

All paintings will remain in the custody of the Rotary Clubs of Applecross and Melville until the above date and time, after this time the organisers are no longer responsible for artworks that have not been collected.



General

Entries not complying with the conditions of entry will not be eligible for hanging.

The organisers reserve the right to decline any work that does not comply with the conditions of entry or is deemed unsuitable for exhibition.

The organisers reserve the right to photograph artworks for promotional purposes.

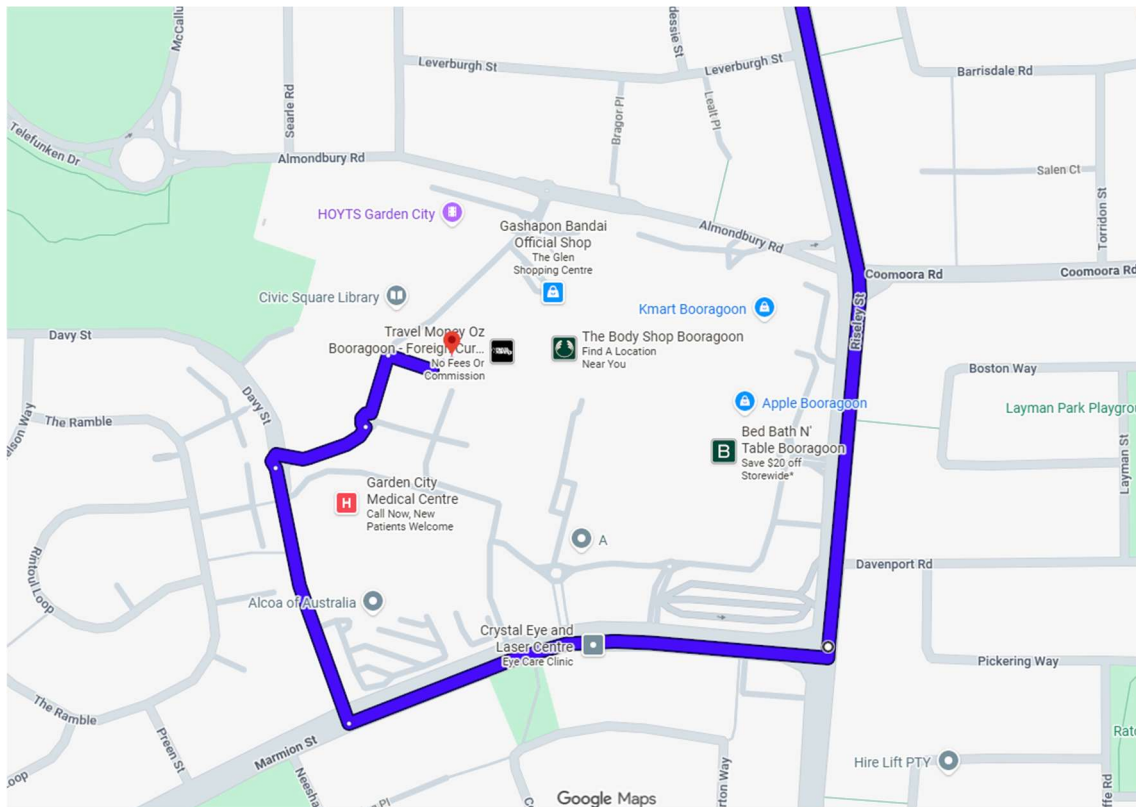

Directions

On the drop-off night please enter the shopping centre via the **Western Mall entrance (Davy Street)**. This entrance is located near the **NAB branch** and is marked on the maps in this document.

If you are travelling along **Riseley Street** from **Canning Highway** or **Leach Highway**, turn onto **Marmion Street** at the traffic lights closest to the **Westfield bus station**.

Follow **Marmion Street** and turn **right onto Davy Street** at the third set of traffic lights.

At the first roundabout take the **second exit (turn right)**. Proceed straight through the next roundabout and then take the **next right into the car park**.

You should see the **NAB signage**, which marks the entrance to the **Western Mall delivery area**.
