North Central Rotary Charity Fund, Inc. Scholarship Guidelines & Application

The North Central Rotary Club Charity Fund, Inc. (NCRC) supports a variety of youth activities, with an emphasis on education. We established the Scholarship for high school students in our area to compete for the scholarships each year for outstanding community service and academic excellence.

Scholarships are awarded to students who meet the eligibility criteria listed below, are selected by the scholarship committee and approved by the San Antonio NCRC board of directors, and who pursue education beyond high school at an accredited institution of higher learning. The funds held will be distributed directly to the educational institution for the benefit of the scholarship award recipient. If an award recipient does not graduate high school or does not attend a qualified educational institution in Texas, the scholarship funds reserved for this designated recipient will revert back to the general scholarship fund.

Eligibility

To be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must:

- (1) Be a student attending The Winston School San Antonio, LEE High School, and Winston Churchill High School.
- (2) Be intending to enroll in an accredited Texas school after graduation from high school or be attending an accredited Texas institution of higher learning.
- (3) Applicants, whose parent(s) or guardian(s) are members of North Central Rotary Club of San Antonio, are ineligible

Application

Only completed application packages will be considered for scholarship award. A complete application includes:

- (1) Application form completed by the student and signed by his/her parent/guardian
- (2) Essay (Between 300 and 500 words)
- (3) No less than 3 letter of recommendation (no more than 1 from School Counselor)
- (4) Official copy of school transcript including attendance (to include Fall Semester of senior year)

- 2 Grades
- 3 Attendance
- 4 Essay
- 5 Personal and school recommendation letters
- 6 Extracurricular Activities
- 7 Education and Career Plans
- 8 Final face-to-face Interview conducted by Scholarship Committee
