Columbus Rotarians annually leverage their skills to improve the lives of people in our community, our country and our world. As part of a global network of 1.2 million Rotarians in 38,000 club around the world, we are passionate about our commitment to "Service Above Self." 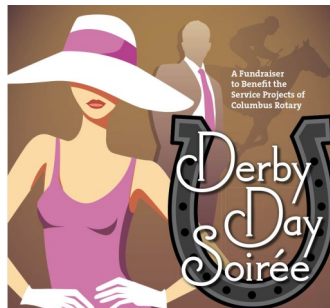
