Guest Speaker Dr Charles Chabert

Dr Chabert is an associate professor operating The Prostate Clinic Gold Coast situated in the Pindarra precinct.

Three conditions affecting the prostate are inflammation, enlargement and cancer.

One of the indicators is the result of the PSA blood test. This can be followed up with an MRI and can be used to biopsy a specific area identified.

Charles then spoke about sexual function and urinary issues.

Erectile dysfunction affects 50% of 70 year old men. Treatment can be tablets, injections vacuum pumps or implants.

Incontinence issues were discussed relating to causes and various treatments.

One members opinion: a fabulous guest speaker in Dr. Charles Chabert, one who knew his subject inside out (so to speak) and held our attention right through his talk.

He spoke so well with little reference to the screen as he went, probably the best speaker we have had in some considerable time
