Naturally, he opts for the most sheer item, pays the \$500, and takes it home, presents it to his wife and asks her to go upstairs, put it on, and model it for him.

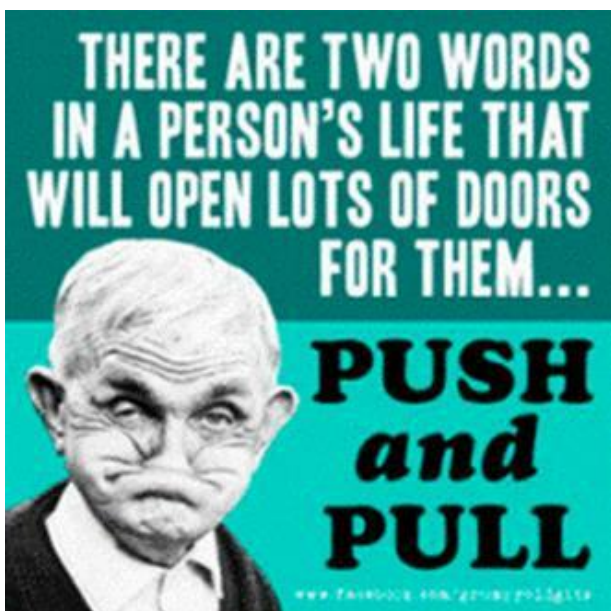
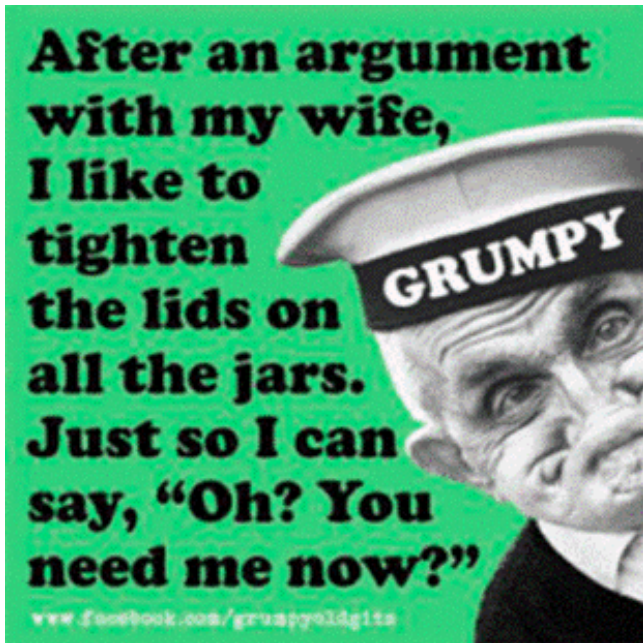
