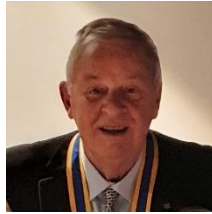

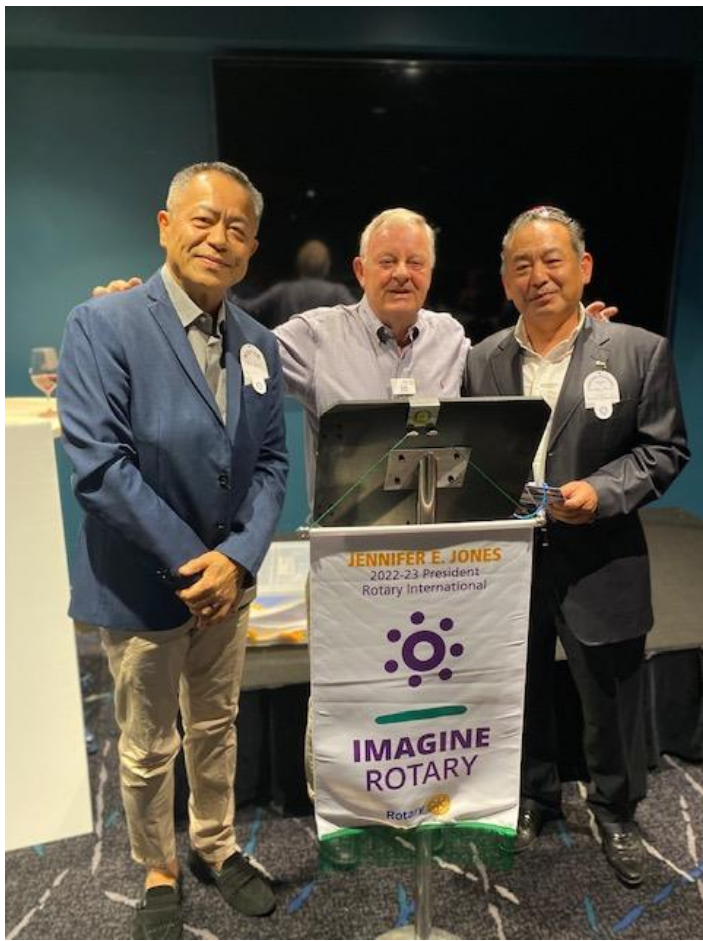
Guest Speaker 5 December.

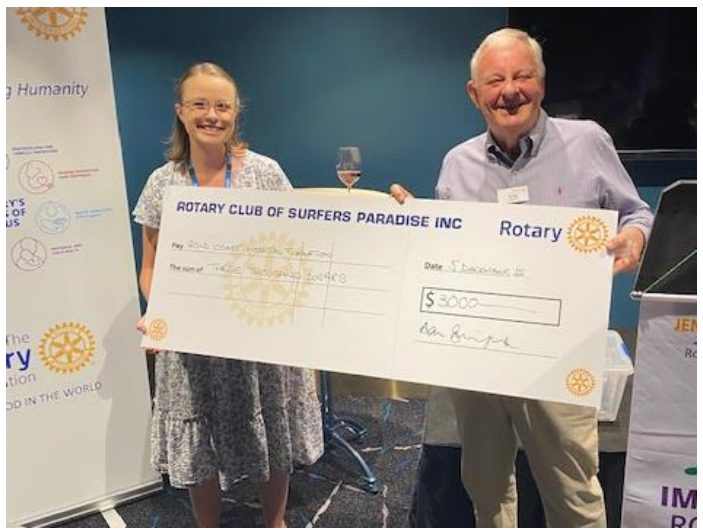
Gifts for Children in Hospital
