LAST WEEK'S MEETING

Last Tuesday was reflections on the Club visit to our long time Sister Club, Takasaki Rotary Club – Tales of Takasaki Travels. Everyone, particularly those who had not travelled and experienced Takasaki RC hospitality before, were blown away with the whole visit.

A couple of important information bits regarding our two club gifts:

President Kirk presented our very individual Commemorative Plaque to the Chairman of Takasaki RC in front of 250 odd gathered Rotarians and guests from all over their District at the 70th Anniversary Celebration. Upon displaying the Plaque there was an immediate and highly audible gasp of amazement and appreciation from the entire audience. They were genuinely very impressed. It will adorn the wall of their office in the hotel.

At the Welcome Party Bill C presented a gift of \(\frac{\pma}{2}\)200,000 (about \(\frac{\pma}{A}\)UD2000) from our Club to be used for relief of the victims of the enormous disaster, Noto Peninsular earthquake earlier this year. This gift was greeted with appreciation and applause. More was to come, however, when we travelled to Koyasan.

Yoshii is the Chief Priest of his Jigengi Temple in Takasaki, which is part of the worldwide Buddhist sect known as Koyasan-Shingon – one of five Buddhist sects worldwide. We were invited into the Kongobuji Temple in Koyasan, which is the World HQ of the Shingon sect. There was an assembly of 10-12 Senior Buddhist Priests gathered around in the Temple and we were all seated in the centre.

It turns out that apparently Takasaki RC had added ¥100,000 to our ¥200,000 and asked Yoshii-San to donate all to the Koyasan Buddhists, who had been actively assisting with feeding, clothing etc the displaced residents of the Noto Peninsular earthquake from the outset. The donation was welcomed enthusiastically and sincerely by the assembled Senior Priests of the Temple, so much so that they had two Official Photographers and a Reporter recording the occasion. Amongst all the Japanese ceremony, "Surfers Paradise Rotary" was heard regularly. A grest result for what we considered was a modest donation. Lots of kudos for Surfers Paradise Rotary, for a donation that was "Doing Good in the World".
