The objective of these scholarships is to provide financial assistance to deserving college-bound high school seniors. Several top recipients will be awarded a scholarship of \$8,000.00 which is funded at \$1,000.00 per semester. Additionally, several recipients will be awarded a one-time award of \$1,000.00. The \$8,000.00 scholarship is renewable each semester. In order to qualify for the renewal the recipient must maintain a 3.0 grade point average and provide a copy of their grades prior to funding.

To be eligible for the scholarships the student must meet these requirements:

- **Graduate from a Jefferson Parish, East Bank high school**
- **Be a resident of Jefferson Parish, East Bank**
- **Be a citizen of the United States of America**

Additional selection criteria include: a student's financial needs, academic grade point average, class ranking, ACT or SAT scores, character, and extra-curricular/volunteer activities. A copy of the student's SAR, Student Aid Report, provided as part of the FAFSA process will be useful along with ACT or SAT scores.

In order to award the scholarships prior to graduation ceremonies, we must have the applications completed and post-marked **no later than March 31, 2023. Please complete the application in its entirety and attach a photo. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
