

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE 29TH ANNUAL
RICE LAKE ROTARY DRY DUCK RAFFLE

1. A maximum of 5,000 raffle tickets will be entered into the drawing.
2. Raffle Drawing will take place at Rice Lake Veterans Memorial Park, at 20 East Stout Street, Rice Lake, WI 54868, at 3:00 P.M. on Sunday, June 10, 2018. All sold duck tickets will be included in the drawing for prizes, consisting of tickets drawn, at random, by the presenter.
3. Ticket drawing will end after all prizes have been awarded.
4. Entrants are allowed to purchase multiple tickets, and are eligible to win multiple prizes
5. A list of prizes can be obtained
from the Presenter by sending a written request therefore, and a
self-addressed stamped envelope to: ROTARY DUCK RACE,

6. Presenter reserves the right, as its sole option, to substitute prizes of
comparable value.

8. The entry portion of each race ticket must be completely filled out
and delivered to Presenter or an authorized representative of Presenter
above and actually received by Presenter prior to the drawing for a ticket
