The GSE to Taiwan is an open vocation GSE. The Korea experience is limited to those in the Arts and Culture vocations. Team leader qualifications are:

- Good knowledge of Rotary, your club and our district.
- Rotarians may be of any age.
- Must be in excellent health for long travel and busy days.
- Needs to be a superb leader who can handle exceptional situations and be a good diplomat.
- Must be able to leave work, family and other responsibilities for the period of the trip.
- Rotarian must be willing to learn some Mandarin Chinese for the Taiwan GSE and some Korean for the Korea GSE.

Some language training will be provided by District 5490 for team leaders, members and alternates. One team leader and one alternate team leader will be selected for each GSE team. GSE information may be found at www.rotary.org or www.rotary5490.org
