

# Student Scholarship Application

## Description

Each semester, the Rotary Club of Kingsville awards a college scholarship to one outstanding student from three area high schools: H.M. King, Riviera, and Academy. School counselors are provided with the scholarship information and application and asked to share it with eligible students. The application is also available on the Rotary Club of Kingsville website at <a href="https://www.rotarykingsville.com">https://www.rotarykingsville.com</a>. Applications must be mailed to the Rotary Club of Kingsville, PO Box 1738, Kingsville, TX 78364. The Rotary Board of Directors will select the winner from applications received by mail. Upon receiving the award, the student will be asked to attend a noon-time Rotary meeting with their counselor, be introduced to the membership, and make a statement regarding their future plans.

#### Student Eligibility

The selected student from each institution must meet the following required criteria:

- A senior student in good standing at the institution whom plans to pursue post-secondary education
- Active in Interact (if available), RYLA, or other Rotary-sponsored events
- Has demonstrated leadership and service characteristics within their community or school
  - O Such as school organizations, volunteer experience, FFA, 4-H, etc.
- Maintains high academic achievement

#### Details

Any scholarship awarded is sent directly to the intended post-secondary institution upon verification of enrollment of the student. If the student already has enrollment information, it should be provided at the time of the award. If enrollment information is not available, the student must contact a member of the Rotary Board of Directors to provide this information once they have enrolled in a post-secondary institution. No personal checks or cash are provided. The student has one year after the award to provide the necessary enrollment information and claim the award. If the student fails to do so, the funds will be reallocated for other purposes. Individual scholarships will not exceed \$500. If a student submits the application but is not chosen in October, they are able to resubmit the application for the March award.
