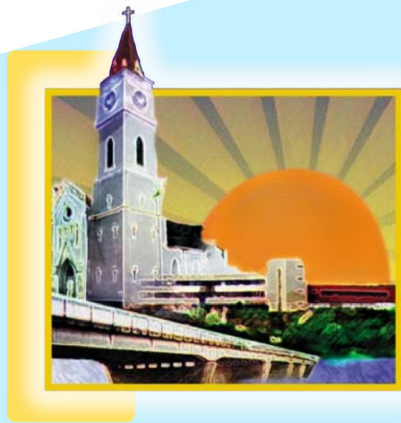

As a stroke survivor who has seen every obstacle imaginable, giving up would have been easy, but "where there's a Bill, there's a way." Along with the support of his family, stroke buddies, countless friends, faith, hope & perseverance, he has beaten all odds.

Born and raised in South Texas, an athlete his entire life, with a root in faith and family, Bill was well on his way to writing a book about coaching and basketball when a severe stroke stopped him in his tracks. For over a decade, he dedicated his time to rehabilitation and researching stroke recovery methods to not only help himself but also help other stroke survivors.

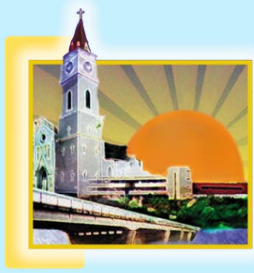
Hrncir and his wife, Deedee, founded the Stroke Support Group after he had a stroke in 2006. The organization was established in 2012 and has provided a space where stroke survivors can find therapy, take part in group activities, and above all else have support.

Their belief is that all survivors should have a supportive environment and accessibility to essential therapy services regardless of their recovery or economic situation. Through a community of support, they have redefined stroke recovery and developed an enriching program for those in need.

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RECAP OF OUR LAST MEETING

For our last meeting, **Jerry Garza, the Webb County Judge-Elect**, was our guest speaker. Jerry Garza is a lifelong Laredoan whose career has spanned public service, education, journalism, business, and community leadership, and he has been deeply involved with Rotary for many years (on and off). Jerry played a key role in founding the Next Generation Rotary Club serving as the charter president.

He spoke about his background as a veteran public servant, business leader, and former television journalist with decades of service in Webb County. He mentioned he has served as a Webb County Commissioner, president of the South Texas County Judges and Commissioners Association, and on the Board of Directors of the Webb County Appraisal District.

He framed his election as the “easy part” of his mission, stressing that the real challenge would be turning campaign promises - which focused on the next 4 years - into a working blueprint for Webb County’s future - which is 50-100 years from now.

Jerry mentioned he brings more of an administrative mentality rather than a politician's mentality. His focus is on our community families, the finances and resources to take care of them, and the future/legacy we will leave to our kids. He acknowledged that we have a tremendous need for infrastructure in our county; and without proper infrastructure we can't grow. He spoke about his plans to help the county by focusing on fiscal responsibility, economic relief, and community well-being
