Judge Jesus M. Dominguez is an accomplished and experienced attorney who currently serves as Presiding Municipal Court Judge for the City of Laredo. Born and raised in Laredo to the late Jesus M. Dominguez and Eloisa Peña de Dominguez, Judge Dominguez was given the opportunity to obtain a private education throughout his youth attending St. Peter's Memorial School and St. Augustine High School, where he graduated in 1982.

Upon graduating high school, he continued his education at Laredo Junior College and then transferred to St. Mary's University in San Antonio. At St. Mary's University, Judge Dominguez became interested in the law and pursued Bachelor's and Master's Degrees in Political Science. While studying for his Master's Degree, he began his commitment to public service as an Adult Probation Officer in Bexar County. After six years working for Bexar County, Judge Dominguez began Law School, obtaining his Juris Doctorate within two and a half years from Thurgood Marshall School of Law in December 1996. Once he completed his education, he returned to Laredo and opened his practice of law.

For over 25 years, Judge Dominguez has worked diligently in various areas of the law, including Administrative, Commercial, Contracts, Criminal, Family, Federal, Municipal, Probate and Real Estate. His diverse experience shows his passion for justice, fairness and the ability to represent individuals on all levels of the justice system.

Judge Dominguez is married to Cindy E. Cantu. He is the father of two daughters, Victoria (Nathan Mendez) and Andrea Dominguez and the grandfather of Elias J. Mendez. He and his wife are animal lovers and have and enjoy 4 dogs (Max, Chloe, Kiki, and Rocco).

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RECAP OF LAST WEEK

During last week's meeting, we had a pleasure of having **Bill Hrnair**, founder of the **Laredo Stroke Support Group (LSSG)** present last Friday. He was accompanied by stroke survivors and caregivers who shared their experiences, the different symptoms they experienced and their road to recovery. Bill spoke about proprioception which is our body's ability to sense its own position, movement, and force in space without relying on our eyes; it works automatically to help us coordinate movements and maintain balance.

Some signs of poor proprioception are trip often, bump into furniture, lose balance, constantly watch one's feet, struggle with minor tasks, problem using stairs.

Factors that can contribute to proprioception problems are: Parkinsons Disease, Multiple Sclerosis, Spinal Injury, Diabetes, and Stroke.

Proprioception impairment can happen after a stroke due to damage in sensory processing areas of the brain, loss of sensory input from affected limbs, or muscle weakness/paralysis. Simple movements become challenges for someone recovering from a stroke.

The Laredo Stroke Support Group offers free therapy activities, monthly meetings, and weekly adaptive programs for stroke survivors, including physical and rehabilitation exercises that can address proprioception needs.
