He is confident that Westinghouse will remain in Cranberry. G.E. just brought in 146 employees. Another Fortune 500 company will be coming shortly. Much roadwork is currently underway; some is completed. There is growth in residential development. We are upgrading our traffic signals. Jerry demonstrated the new MSA throughway that will connect Cranberry Springs and Cranberry Woods. We are always improving our parks and recreation, most done by private donations. We are upgrading the water and sewer treatment plants and the water meters. 1.5 billion visitors were here in 2015. The block party trailer is a success to build social capital. Cracker Barrel restaurant construction is underway.
