Ball Drop:

This past Saturday, we held our First Annual Ball Drop Event at the YMCA during the Healthy Kids Day. Thank you to the various members who donated their time to help make both events widely successful. After a couple last minute ticket funds being added, we ended up profiting around \$3,600 in which we decided to distribute:

Strong Kids Campaign: \$1,500 Suicide Prevention & Awareness: \$1,000 Cranberry Volunteer Fire Department: \$750

The rest of the proceeds will be deposited in our account for future uses.

New Member:

In a unanimous vote, Curt Whipple of Cranberry Township was accepted into our club today. We are excited to see how Curt can contribute to our great club and the community. It is a great thing to see our club growing with the New Year!

Garden:

It was requested and granted for up to \$1,500 in funds to revamp our Rotary Garden that is located near Home Depot in Cranberry Township. Denny Mason and Ralph Sterzinger will head the effort and plan to replace the shrubbery with a more visually pleasing set of Annuals.

Suicide Prevention & Awareness Walk:

As we revel in our great efforts from the Ball Drop, it is now time to focus on our upcoming event of "Suicide Prevention & Awareness Walk". We need to focus on creating and maintaining a buzz within our community to get sponsors and walkers for the event. Rich has suggested, and it was granted, to put some funds into an online Facebook promotion to increase and spread awareness of this event in Cranberry and the surrounding areas.
