### Secretary's Report:

Rich opened up the discussion by presenting his findings on his research regarding crowdfunding and PayPal fees. He started by stating that he researched IndieGoGo, which is among the largest crowdfunding platforms available. The fee is a flat 5% and typically links with PayPal for credit card processing which is around 3-5% for each transaction. He went on to discuss the features of PayPal and how it can help us be more organized for the Ball Drop. As previously mentioned, PayPal will take around 3-5% for credit card processing but would allow us to have a digital platform to accept payments for events. This will allow us to more effectively reach our target demographic and give them a way to pay digitally.

Jenn added to Rich's assessment of PayPal and liked the idea. She suggested that we set up a separate account to receive payments online. This will minimize the availability of funds should we ever get hacked or have our account compromised.
