
CRANBERRY TOWNSHIP NOON ROTARY

She made it a point to make sure that she did what she wanted and felt comfortable to do and encouraged everyone to exercise their right as well when appropriate. Susan took about a year to finish her book due to several complications and under the mercy of her co-authur whom happened to be her doctor that helped her through the process. Susan is currently in remission and seems very healthy and energetic. Susan's Book "Don't Write the Obituary Yet" is available for purchase at \$16.99 and all proceeds are donated to Ovarian Cancer research. Among many accolades, Susan is also a long service member of Rotary International and is always welcome to our meetings.
