STARTING THE RIDE:

ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO SOCIAL DISTANCE AND WEAR FACE MASKS BEFORE AND AFTER EVENT START IN ALL EVENT AREAS.

1. **ONLY ONLINE REGISTRATION ON DAY OF EVENT.** There will be no paper registration so any same day sign-ups will need to occur online.
2. Check-in: Participants will check in and review the health guidelines. Hand sanitizer will be distributed to every rider.
3. **Staggered start – to help with social distancing, we ask that you arrive/start at the times based upon your last name or the bicycle club name. We recognize that you may be riding with friends who are in different groups, so choose one based on a rider in that group.**

8:00 am – A through E
8:30 am – F through K
9:00 am – L through P
9:30 am – Q through U
10:00 am – V through Z

4. New this year - shirts and pies will be distributed at the finish of the ride only.
5. Water: Bottled water will be provided and distributed by a volunteer. Please do not help yourself to minimize touch points.
6. Riders are required to practice safe social distancing and adhere to the safety guidance. Do not group together at the start line or finish line and maintain spacing at rest stops.
7. After crossing the start line, you may remove your mask if you choose. Do not discard your mask as you will need it at the rest stops and/or at the finish line. Please help us stay safe and do not dispose of masks or other trash on the route.

ON THE ROUTES:

1. Bike helmets are required. Helmets must be on and strapped prior to crossing the start line. Extra helmets are not available.
2. Event volunteers will distribute bottled water at the start line, rest stops and finish line.
3. Pre-packaged snacks will be available. Any garbage must be disposed of in trash receptacles and not on the route or in parks.
4. Recreation path and portions of the course will be open to pedestrian and/or vehicle traffic throughout this event.

5. Ride on the right side of the course on paths and roads, allowing traffic and faster riders to pass safely on the left side.
6. When passing on the left, give ample distance and announce “passing on left” if possible.
7. There is no posted time limit to the event. However, sag support and race officials may pull support at the end of the event even if riders remain on the course. The anticipated sag support end time is Noon.
8. Riders still on the course attempting to finish the event are still required to comply with event rules and Covid-19 safety.
9. Riders will be responsible for following proper rules of the road.

FINISHING THE RIDE:

Upon completion of the ride, each rider is expected to do the following:

1. Cross the finish line and pick-up your pie and t-shirt.
2. Water will be available. A volunteer wearing a mask/gloves will hand you a bottled water. Please wait until they can assist you.
3. After finishing the ride, all participants are required to promptly:
 - a. Return to wearing a face mask.
 - b. Practice social distancing guidelines of staying six feet apart. Do not congregate in groups.
 - c. Exit the area as quickly as possible to keep everyone safe.

OTHER ITEMS TO NOTE:

1. Hand sanitizer and extra masks will be available.
2. Social distancing signs will be displayed throughout the event area, and volunteers will also be reminding participants to social distance.
3. Everyone inside the event area is requested to wear a face mask when not riding.
4. Spectators will be limited for everyone’s safety. We encourage spectators to not group together and to wait outside the main event areas.

Your cooperation with these guidelines will allow a fun and safe event for all!
