



Quixote Communities is a 501c3 non-profit providing supportive services and recovery housing that came out of the support of a tent city in Olympia, WA. We provide permanent supportive housing for people experiencing homelessness. We create and manage tiny home villages that foster community, encourage personal growth, and promote access to the care and services residents need.

We have villages in Olympia (Thurston County), Orting Veterans (Pierce County) and coming soon Shelton Veterans (Mason County). Each village has a minimum of 30 (144 sf) individual units that include a full restroom (and in newer models a shower) as well as a community building (2500 sf) that includes a full kitchen, recreation room, storage space and office space. Transportation is provided as needed.

Our case managers work one-on-one with residents to create goals for their future that include employment, education, financial and physical well-being. We offer a clean and sober environment to our residents who are in all stages of recovery. Supportive services include therapies (group and individual), housing vouchers, food security, pet assistance, medication management and medically assisted treatment (if needed). Residents offer each other peer mentorship that often lead to rich and meaningful relationships.
