What is it?

Who is Eligible?

Children from birth until their fifth birthday who are residents of the Buena Vista School District R-31 or Salida School District R-32-J.

When parents read books to their children from birth, it provides them with the best possible start. Children develop literacy skills long before being able to read, and it is important to start at birth.
