



# Q1 Why did you initially join the Salida Sunrise Rotary Club? (Please select as many reasons as apply.)






### Q2 Why do you stay in the SSR club?






## Q3 What is your overall satisfaction in the club?






Q4 Prioritize your interest in the 5 Avenues of Service below using 1 through 5, with 1 having the most interest and 5 having the least interest.






# Q5 Is our club achieving the Rotary principal motto of 'Service Above Self'?








#### Q7 How would you prefer to spend your time in Rotary? Please select all that apply.










Q10 We would like to explore meeting attendance. Please answer the following questions with a yes or no.






# Q11 Have you considered leaving Rotary in the past year?






#### Q12 If you have considered or are considering leaving the club, what are your reasons?






### Q13 What is your employment status?
