The [Portrait of a Graduate](#) design process engages the educational system and our broader community to help us build a unifying, collective vision for Moline-Coal Valley School District students. Bringing together many diverse perspectives across our community will be essential for ensuring long-lasting educational transformation.

During this **four part** process close to 100 community stakeholders will identify shared aspirations through the consideration of the following important questions:

- What are the hopes, dreams, and aspirations that our community has for its students?
- What are the skills and mindsets our children need for success in this rapidly changing, complex world?
- What are the implications for the design of the learning experiences—and equitable access to those experiences—we provide in our school systems?

The process in total will consist of **4 evening meetings**, held at Moline High School, during the spring semester. **Two will be in March, one in April, and one in May.** I would be thrilled if as many of you as possible would be willing to join us on this project.

The dates are below. The meetings will take place at Moline High School and will be scheduled for 2.5 hours each, beginning at 5:30pm. It is preferred if you can commit to attending all (*or most*) of the sessions.

- Meeting 1: **Tuesday, March 14th**
- Meeting 2: **Tuesday, March 28th**
- Meeting 3: **Tuesday, April 25th**
- Meeting 4: **Wednesday, May 17th**

This is a unique one-time opportunity for our district and your involvement would be valued and appreciated. We would value your leadership and insights.
