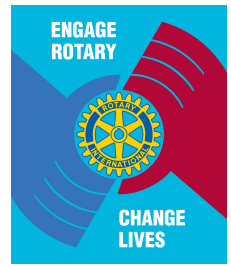

## Tips for Tasty Corned Beef

**Don't Skimp** - get a nice, red beef brisket and remember it shrinks as you cook when selecting a size.

**Have Patience** - less tender meats need slow heat over a long period of time, approx. 50 minutes for each pound of meat.

**Spice it Up** - add to the spice packet that's included with allspice, peppercorns, coriander, mustard seed or even fresh garlic.

**Share Your Beer** - pour some on your corned beef for added flavor and moisture. If you choose a bitter beer, balance it with brown sugar.
