Instructions for Teachers and Students

Thank you for participating in the 2018-2019 Rotary District 5190 Speech Contest.

Important Points to Know

1. In most areas, the speech contest has three levels. First is the local club contest, held between February and March, 2019. The second is an area contest, held between March and April, 2019. The final level is the District Speech Contest, to be held at the District Conference on May 18, 2019, time TBD, at Peppermill, Reno, NV. **STUDENTS MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR ALL THREE LEVELS TO ENTER IN THE COMPETITION.**
2. Only the winner at each level advances to the next level. Club and area contest have 2-5 contestants; the District contest has 7-13. The cash prizes at the district level are \$1,000 (1st), \$750 (2nd) and \$500 (3rd). Club and area prizes are the responsibility of the participating clubs.
3. Contest rules are available at your local school or Rotary club.
4. Your local Rotary club is responsible for furnishing you with all of the information needed to compete at each level of the contest.
5. A student may enter only one club contest in their own area.

Speech Contest Rules

Theme: With Rotary's motto being "Service Above Self" and this year's Rotary theme being "Be The Inspiration," how do you see yourself being inspirational?

- Time: 5 – 7 Minutes
- Entrants: Must be from District 5190 clubs and in grades 9 – 12
- Club Prizes: To be determined by club
- Area Prizes: To be determined by participating clubs
- District Prizes: \$1,000 for 1st Place, \$750 for 2nd Place and \$500 for 3rd Place

CONTEST RULES

- Notes: Contestants may use written notes at the club contest ONLY
- Microphone: A microphone must be used at the District contest
- Props: No displays, props or prompting is allowed
- Judges: Use 4 judges and 1 tiebreaker at all contests. They may be Rotarians
- Arrival Time: All contestants MUST arrive at contest location NO LATER than 10 minutes before the start of the contest. Late arrivals will be DISQUALIFIED. NO EXCEPTIONS.

SUGGESTED COMPETITION TIMELINES

- Club Contest: February – March, 2019 Deadline
- Area Contest: Before April 15, 2019 Deadline

All Area Speech contestant finalist names and contact information is due to Jeanne Schmidt Herron no later than April 15, 2019 (FIRM).

District Speech contest is on May 18, 2019, Time TBD
at Peppermill, Reno, NV

Contestants must be available to speak at both the Area and District contests in order to enter the club contest. A student may only speak at one club in their area.
