## OFFICIAL RULES



### THE TEAMS

Each team will have one (1) to four (4) members. One of these will be the team captain, who will act as a spokesperson.

### THE PLAY

There will be three (3) Rounds of questions. If there is a tie after Round 3 for first, second, or third place, there will be Tie Breaker Rounds to break the tie until a clear 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> can be declared.

The top three teams at the end of Round 3, and the Tie Breakers, if any are needed, will receive cash prizes: \$500 for 1st place, \$250 for 2nd place, \$100 for 3rd place.

Before each Round, you will be told how long you will have to respond to each question in the Round.

The team's response to each question will be written on the official answer sheet. Teams should verify that their team name is on their sheet. The sheet should have only your final answer to each question.

Do not shout out answers. Keep your team discussions to a low whisper. To communicate, use the provided notepads.

Following each Round, Proctors will collect the answer sheets, score them, and return them to the teams. (While the answer sheets are being scored, it's a great time to refill your drinks or get more food!) If you have questions or issues about the scoring, your captain should summon a proctor for resolution. The proctor will make the FINAL DECISION.

One point is given for each correct answer. There are no penalties for wrong answers, just no points. Each new Round starts at zero (0).

Each Round consists of 15 questions. After the Round is scored, the scores will be posted.

### TIE BREAKERS

If there is no clear 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place teams, the teams tied will play a Tie Breaker Round(s).

A Tie Breaker Round will consist of a single question. Each team in contention will receive a Tie Breaker answer sheet and will write its team name and answer on it. Each team's answer will be verified by a Proctor. If ties still exist, single question rounds will continue until the top 3 teams are identified.

### IN FAIRNESS TO ALL...

During play, no books, prepared notes, electronic devices such as phones, tablets, or laptops. No conferring with anyone not on your team. Teams in violation will be disqualified and no refunds will be available.

Spectators may not sit in the playing area during play and may not contribute to play in any way, such as by calling out answers. They may join you between rounds but must leave the playing area before the next round and/or a tie breaker begins. Spectators who want one will be provided an answer sheet to play for fun, but their scores won't be counted.

### AND FINALLY...

After the top three teams are determined, the Jackson Rotary Trivia Challenge 2020 winners will be announced, and prizes awarded.
