Live Polio numbers:	2019	2020
Afghanistan	29	56
Pakistan	147	82

99% reduction since 1988. 1988 250,000 cases per year to 276 in 2019. We are so close. Two and half billion children have been immunized. 2020 Nigeria declared polio free. The entire continent of Africa is now polio free.

District 5190 has a PolioPlus Society which you could become a member of with a minimum donation of \$100 per year. David presented to Jan Recanzone a certificate of membership.

Rotary with its partners in the fight against Polio has been assisting with worldwide COVID observations and using assets in the fight against COVID.
