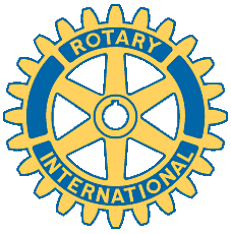
April 10: Liz Broscoe presenting Durgas Drum Story

- **Rotary International Foundation: For several years, it has been stressed that Foundation support – while voluntary – is something Rotarians are expected to do.** The reason is that the Foundation is the major way that Rotary promotes peace: Foundation projects alleviate the conditions of poverty, poor sanitation, and poor healthcare that make efforts at achieving peace possible. Our ongoing Club goal (and District 5190 goal) has been that each member is a sustaining member of the Foundation, contributing \$100/year to the Annual Fund. If \$100 is not affordable, it is a goal that every member contribute something, and that the Club average \$100 per member.
- **What does the Rotary International Foundation do?** If you have any questions about the details of activities that your Foundation contributions support, please consult the District and club websites. Foundation annual programs currently amount to about \$130 million per year. Rotary.org will also give you access to RI Foundation information.
