
Alturas Sunrise Rotary Membership Proposal Procedures

1. Membership Proposal Form is completed by Member & returned to Membership Committee.
 2. Perspective member is a Guest at a minimum of 3 meetings.
 3. Proposal reviewed by Membership Committee. The committee ensures that the person is fully qualified and approves or disapproves the proposal within 14 days of receipt of Proposal Form.
 4. If approved, Classification is assigned. If disapproved, they will notify the proposer of decision.
 5. Perspective member's name is published to the club membership for one week, if no objections.
 6. Proposal is approved by the Board
 7. Orientation is given to the Perspective member (Fireside Chat).
 8. Member data forms are completed, including payment of admission fee, prorated annual dues (quarterly basis), and prorated meeting fees (quarterly basis).
 9. Club President arranges for the induction of new member into the Club.
 10. Sponsor presents new member to the club during induction ceremony.
 11. President may assign a member to assist the sponsor in the assimilation of new member into the culture and customs of the club.

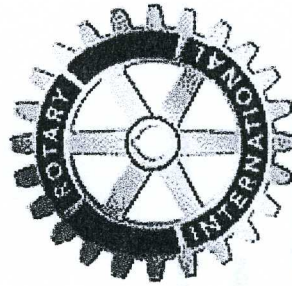
Summary of Membership Provisions for New Members

General Qualifications – Rotarians are adults of good character and good business or professional reputation, who hold or have held an executive position with discretionary authority in any worthy and recognized business or profession.

Active membership – Active members must meet the above qualifications, as well as live or work within the club's locality or surrounding area.

Classification – Each active member of a Rotary club is classified in accordance with the member's business or profession. A classification describes the principal and recognized activity of the firm with which an active member is connected or the member's principal and recognized business or professional activity.

Note: Holders of public office. Persons elected or appointed to public office for a specified time are not eligible for active membership under the classification of such office, except persons elected or appointed to judiciary or educational offices.
