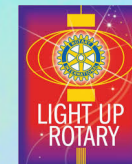

VOCATIONAL SPOTLIGHT - ARLIN BILLINGTON

Arlin Billington is a long time member of Rotary and a founding member and Past President of the Rotary Club of Susanville Sunrise. Arlin grew up in Eureka California and ventured out at an early age to find a career in retail in Eugene Oregon. When an opportunity arose to do store set-ups for Coast-to-Coast Hardware, Arlin jumped at the chance to travel around 7 western states and learn the retail hardware trade. In 1983 he formed a partnership with two other men to buy and operate five Coast-to-Coast stores in Oregon. Looking to become more independent, Arlin sold his share of the partnership and bought the Coast-to-Coast store in Susanville in 1990 which he reorganized under the co-op umbrella of Ace Hardware in 1997. Arlin derives his greatest satisfaction from his business by problem solving, interacting with customers, and serving the community. Billington's Ace Hardware has long been respected in Susanville for its generous support of 4-H, Scouting, and many other community activities. Arlin's vocation exemplifies the true spirit of Rotary's service to community through good business practice.
