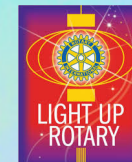

Shaffer School REGL Students



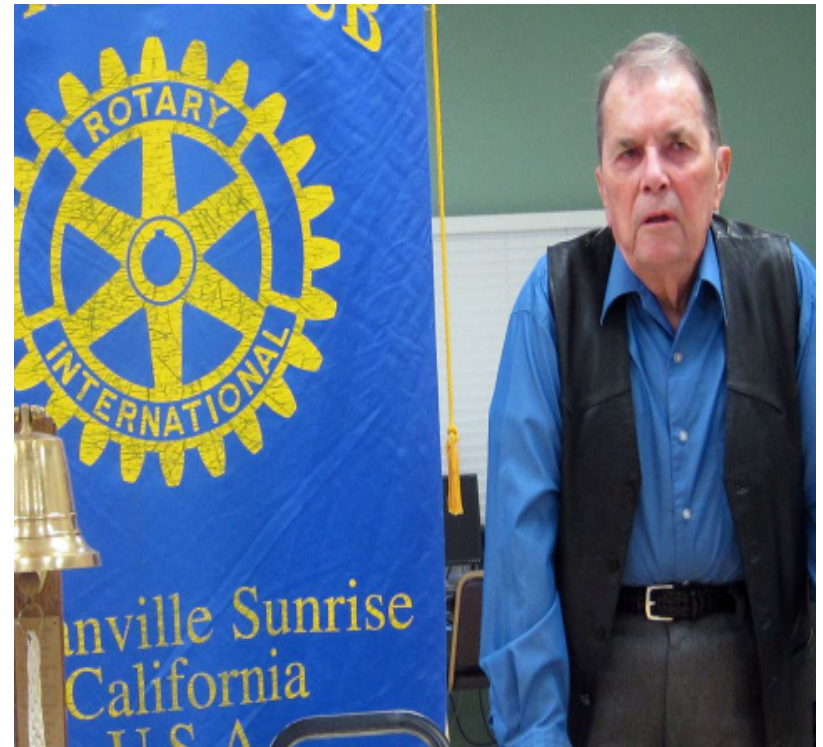
