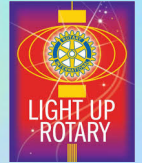

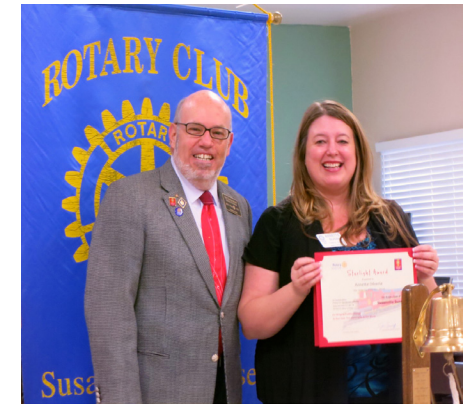


# Last Week
