

#### **World Polio Day**

Emmy Award-winning actress Archie Panjabi spoke passionately about why she is so committed to her work as a Rotary ambassador for polio eradication. "When I was a child 10 years old, I went to India. As I walked to school, I would see children younger than me with no [use of their] limbs, begging for



money," Panjabi said.
"It broke my heart."
Inspired as an adult to learn more about polio, she was "amazed by the amount of work that Rotary has done," in helping India be free of the disease since 2011, and joined a team of Rotary volunteers to immunize children there last year. "I will do what-

ever I can to support Rotary and its partners in the Global Polio Eradication Initiative . . . . And if you do whatever you can, then together we can eradicate polio forever."
