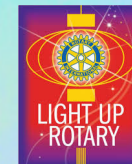

Its purpose is to offer professional leadership training to selected 8th grade students as they prepare for the high school experience. Attendance is by scholarship only; students are selected by the principal. There is no cost to the student or the school for this training. All costs are covered by the Rotary Clubs. All sessions are conducted under the direction of Dean and Rochelle Whellams, who are also the program directors for the RYLA program (Rotary Youth Leadership Awards).



Robert Talley, Technology Coordinator for Lassen County Office of Education, supports internet and phone service at all schools in the county, including Charter Schools. He noted that schools now have sheriff sub-stations on campus, with a lot of cameras. “Things in IT change rapidly, and the learning environment has also changed,” he said.
