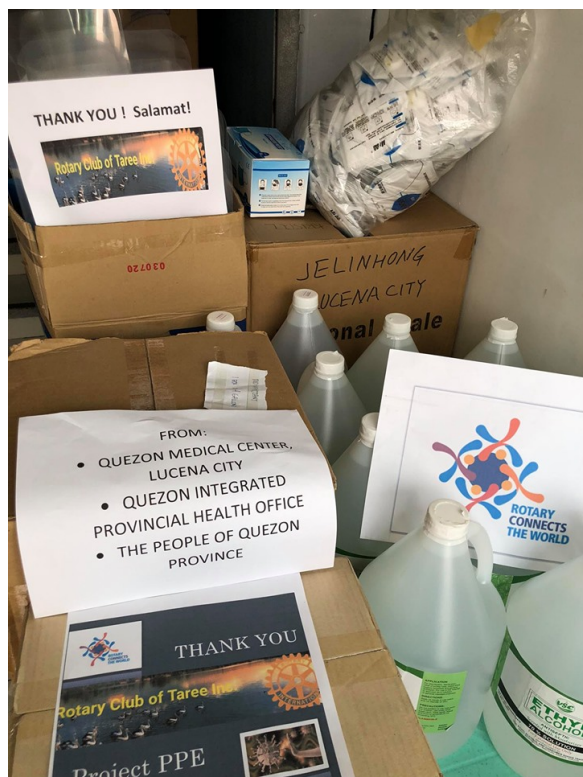

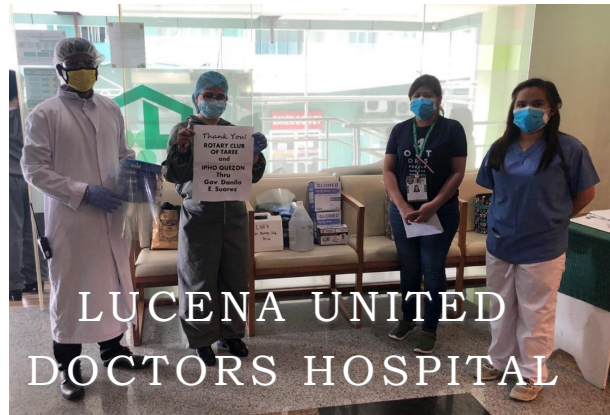
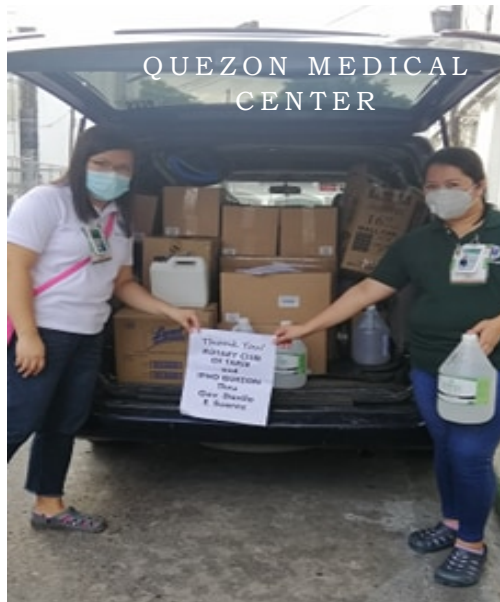

Dear All:

In April 1, 2020, I requested assistance in helping us, Quezon Province, Philippines to prevent the spread of the virus. We had 9 confirmed cases then and now we have 72 confirmed cases, 29% recovered and 10% died. By far, we have the lowest incidence rate for Region IVA (CaLaBaRZon). For our laboratory findings, out of the 1223 suspect cases, 75% tested negative for the virus.

We will try to maintain our low incidence and hopefully lessen our fatalities. Your donated Protective Personal Equipment (PPE) and disinfectants have helped us a lot in making sure our front liners and healthcare workers are safe and assured us of a better way to contain the virus. The provincial government of Quezon, under the leadership and administration of Governor Danilo E. Suarez, together with all of the constituents of our province, both public and private sectors extend our heartfelt gratitude to you and the community of which each of you represent. We thank our “kababayan”, Dr. Grace Maano, for being our bridge, making sure that our immediate needs during this pandemic reach your hearts.

COVERALLS DELIVERED

The other half of funds are to fund the sewing of coveralls. Out of our target 100 coveralls, 65 coveralls were finished and were turned over last Sunday 10th of May to the Covid Ward at Quezon Medical Centre. Because we managed to get most of these coveralls sewn for free labour by an NGO called TESDA – the extra funds are used to purchase more taffeta materials (300 yards) to be sewn by TESDA in the coming days and we are hoping we will be able to complete the target of 100 coveralls, or more.
