Following the successful application for Stronger Communities funding from Mid Coast Council, the combined community services clubs of the Manning Valley are well on target to build a signature stage facility on the banks of our magnificent Manning River.

The proposal is to construct the stage straddling the riverbank in Queen Elizabeth Park, Taree where the mighty Manning will be its backdrop. The stage has been specifically designed to be multi-purpose – musical and theatrical productions, outdoor cinema, civic and sporting presentations to name just a few. The facility is also available for private hire. Just imagine what the possibilities could be!

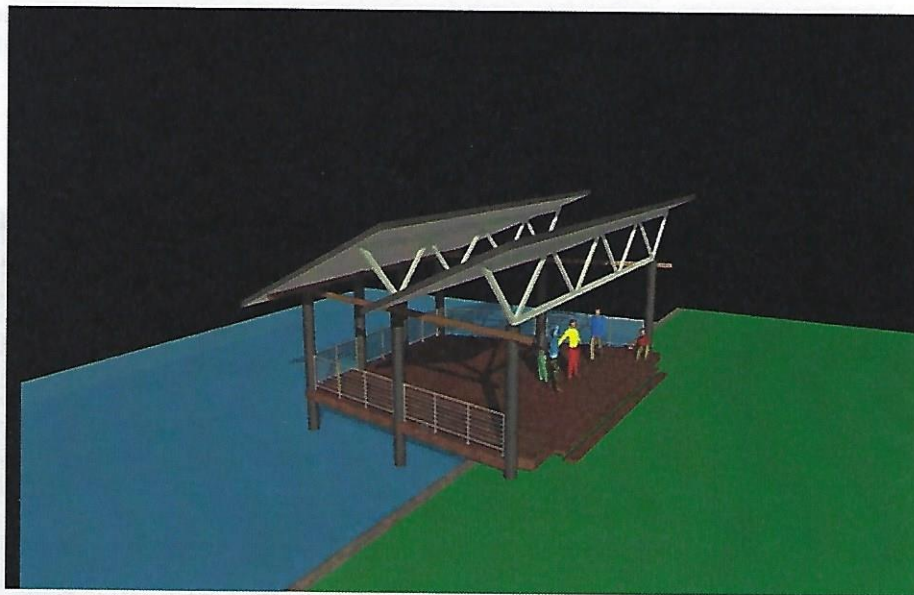
We still need your help.

Although we have the grant for \$50,000, the budget for the build is a little over \$100,000 and we must raise the remainder to ensure this project becomes a reality. A number of pledges have already been made but we've still a shortfall to make up. Our community has started to donate via our crowd-funding site. See below.
