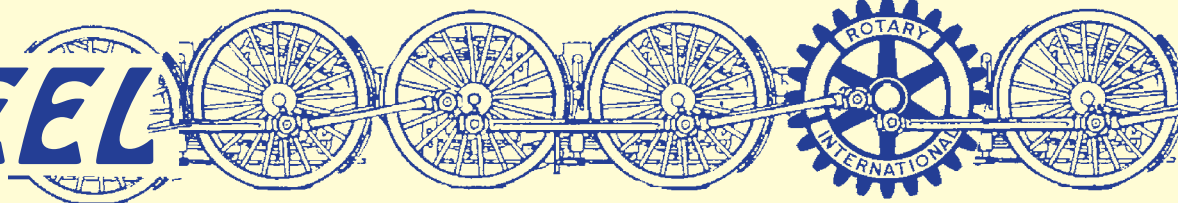

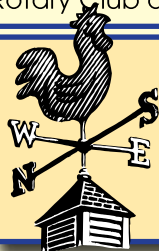

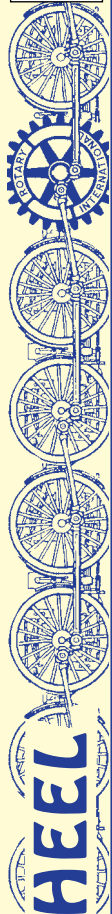

WORLD COMMUNITY SERVICE Zua Foundation

The country of Colombia has the highest number of displaced people in the world. The UN estimates 8 million displaced with almost 5 million still within the country of Colombia. In 2018, **Peian Harness** became the international lead on a project with the Rotary Club of Bogotá Centenario on a Global Grant for Peace. The purpose was to support children and young people living in difficult situations with art, music and educational programs. Our Club is continuing to finance this program with yearly donations from the Novato Endowment (\$2,000 in 2020-21). During the pandemic (and strikes within the country), the Zua Foundation has continued to provide support to both the children and parents. This has included internet access to do school work, tutors and a Parents' School, a program aimed at training mothers in the most critical problems in the education of their children, such as; child sexual abuse, social networks, cyber games, bullying. Zua Foundation has even managed to continue their music program for children over the internet.
