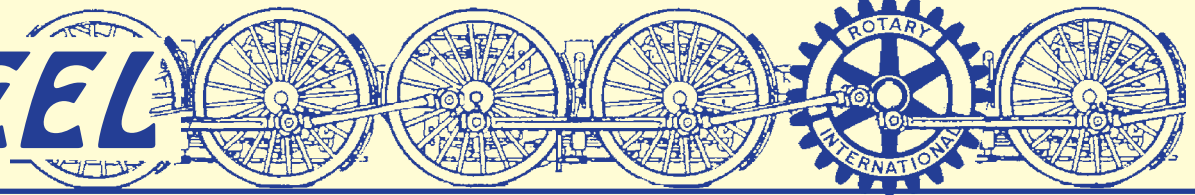

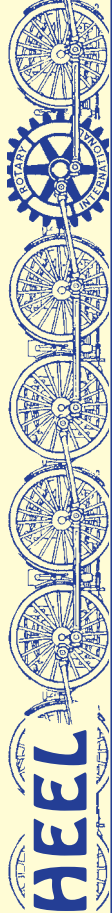

With surreptitious help, he "hid" as a student at a Catholic school in the forest near Luxembourg for over 2 years. After reuniting with his mother, the two eventually came to the United States and settled in Petaluma.

To kick off the festivities, Cantor David Margule will start performing at 7:00 PM. Cantor David Margule's beautiful tenor voice has enhanced and blessed members of Congregation Rodef Sholom since 1991. As the synagogue's cantor and musical director, he choreographs services and leads the congregation in traditional prayers and new arrangements - enjoining them to sing out with him and the rabbis.
