

Contest Rules, Deadline, and More

The **Stop Litter Campaign Video Contest** is open to all middle and high school students in both public and private schools in Novato.

The video should contain an enticing and educational message that teaches people to stop littering. The video should teach viewers to put their trash in a garbage can or other appropriate receptacle, and never throw it on the ground. Viewers should also be asked to encourage others to stop littering.

Videos should be 30-60 seconds in length, capturing the message of stop littering in a creative, animated way and can use some of the following ideas: a mascot, characters, words, music, animation, a memorable saying or jingle, and/or other methods of relaying this important message.

Videos may be an individual or team effort. A team is no more than five students.

An Entry Form from each individual as well as each individual on a team must be submitted with the video.

The Contest will commence on April 4, 2022, and all entries must be submitted by April 29, 2022.

Winners will receive notice of their selection by May 27, 2022.

Cash awards will be given at a Novato Rotary meeting on June 3, 2022.

Ownership of the video submitted for the contest will remain with the video producer(s). However, Novato Rotary reserves the right to reproduce and publish any and all video work submitted by a student/team and publish the individual or team members' names, ages, and school for promotional and marketing use.
