Margaret Coval, started the Christmas Train of San Diego/Tecate 21 years ago with her husband, As a memorial to a young relative who died in a car accident. Margaret met with the folks who have kept it going recently. Due to aging and illnesses, it was decided to terminate it, unless some others wish to step forwards. So, Margaret asks that La Mesa Sunrise Rotary be roundly thanked for its support, financial, spiritual physical and otherwise, over the last 18 years. Many of our current Rotarians have taken the trip down to Tecate with the Christmas Train and participated in the event, handing out Mardi Gras necklaces, etc.

Those of us who went will always recall the smiles and wonder on the faces of the four to six thousand kids, how well behaved they were, and how very appreciative were their elders, parents, guardians, etc.

The original trips were to be for the benefit of the poor: at that time, unemployment in upper Baja, including Tecate, was 40%. Each kid was given a sizeable bag containing school supplies, some fruit, a piece of clothing, a new, boxed toy, notebooks, and whatever else had been donated.
