### SDG&E'S METEOROLOGICAL DATA

#### BRIAN D'AGOSTINO



This week's guest speaker was Brian D'Agostino of SDG&E.

D'Agostino is SDG&E's Meteorologist and Program Manager and he delivered some fascinating information. For instance, did you now that SDG&E has the largest weather network in the world? With over 170 weather stations, you can access their content for free at [www.sdgeweather.com](http://www.sdgeweather.com). Club members learned about various indices such as the Fire Potential Index, a seven-day forecast that is compiled in part from satellites that measure the greenness of our grass DAILY. Who knew?

We also saw visuals of the Santa Ana Wildlife Threat Index, Fire Behavior Model, Outage Potential Index and Solar Potential Index. What was most interesting were the graphics that placed historical fires at the very high end of the Fire Potential Index, meaning that Fire Services are now working with the most sophisticated prevention tools to keep us safe. and all the fire emergency services countywide.
