### PROGRAM: HANDS OF PEACE

Sarah Heirendt, director of Hands of Peace (San Diego), was introduced by Joy Prowse as part of our programming for February, Rotary International's Peace Month.

Hands of Peace (San Diego), a local, Carlsbad based organization, offers a comprehensive set of summer programs to bring teenagers from Israel, Palestine, and the US together to create impactful and lasting change through developing future leaders who are committed to a positive and just peace. Together through three week summer programs and advanced follow-up, they explore the conflict together, gain exposure to each other's narratives and faiths, share personal stories for greater understanding of individual differences and common humanity, and explore individual and group actions that can be taken as involved leaders.

Hands of Peace was started in Chicago in 2003, and has been active in the San Diego area for six years. Each year they bring together 46 teens from the three nations and diverse religious backgrounds to learn and grow together over a three week period. The full cost of the program and travel is \$5,000 per participant, but scholarships are provided to those in need.
