MEETING OF JANUARY 22, 2018

To the tune of "New River Train" President David Harrison introduced the Greatest Club in the Universe. Master at Arms Jim Brubaker confirmed that all was in order and President David rang a new bell provided by Jim.

Sunshine Steve Mott led all in the singing of "This Land is Your Land" (accompanied by **President David** on the banjo) and then lead us all singing of "My Darlin' Clementine".

President **David** reported he had just returned from one plus week trip to Vietnam where he visited the village of A Luoi where, in co-operation with **Rotary District 6600** and the **Rotary Club of Singapore**, **Carlsbad Hi-Noon Rotary**, is undertaking a Rotary International Global Grant of \$71,000 to provide sanitation and running clean water facilities to this small mountain village of some 1,200 people made up of about 300 families. He showed a brief video of the welcome the Rotarians received from the school children.

Guests of Rotary included Jason (a former Navy SEAL), Danielle, our guest speaker Sheri Nasim and Craig Jones.

Justin Peak provided Words of Wisdom by asking who in the room set New Year's Resolutions. He then stated that "Excellence is no more than repeated habits" and provided a handout to all about the "No Excuses Mentality" system of Tom Bartow & Dr.

Jason Selk. He challenged all to engage in working on this. **President David** noted (after **Justin** had concluded) that this was, to his memory, the first time a **Words of Wisdom** had concluded with a homework assignment.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

President David continued to report on his trip to Vietnam with slides and a video of the trip. He noted that A Luoi is located about 60 kilometers inland form Hue, the site of much heavy fighting during the Vietnam War. A Luoi is situated in mountainous, jungle terrain. He showed photos of the clean water systems running next to each residence and outdoor toilets throughout the village. He also showed an elementary school classroom where students are taught environmental science and health including how to maintain the new sanitation systems. He noted that several members of Singapore Rotary have businesses in Vietnam and are hopeful of introducing Rotary to the country which currently has none. Finally, he noted that all the Vietnamese he met on his trip were very friendly toward him and the other Americans in the group.

President David noted a number of upcoming events: Friday the City of Carlsbad's official homeless person count will occur and members of our club will be participating as a part of our homeless services effort as a club.

January 27th from 6-9 pm is the District 5400 social at the **Agua Hedionda Lagoon Center** to which all are invited and encouraged to bring guests who may have an interest in becoming Rotarians. Prizes will be awarded.

February 1st at 4:30 pm the Club Board will have its monthly meeting followed by a Fire-side Chat at 6 pm. All Red Badge Rotarians are encouraged to attend since attending one of each is a Blue Badge requirement. This event will also be held at **Agua Hedionda Lagoon**.

The first round of the District 5400 high school instrumental music competition is set for 7 pm on Thursday, February 8th at Carlsbad by the Sea. So far eleven contestants have applied to enter our local competition.

The **Mexico House Project** is set for Saturday, March 3rd from 6 am to 6 pm. See **Al Wanamaker** if you want to sign up to go and build the house. Meet at the La Costa Avenue park and ride lot.

The annual **Rotary District Assembly** is set for Saturday, March 24th from 7:45 am to 12 noon at the **Joan Kroc Center at University of San Diego**. While all members are encouraged to attend to learn about what is going on in all avenues of service, Red Badge Rotarians are urged to attend this ½ day event to get an in depth look at all that Rotary does and is doing.
