## PROGRAM - RADM Dan Dwyer – Carrier Strike Group 9

Rear Admiral Dan Dwyer – Carrier Strike Group 9 introduced us to this San Diego based strike group, consisting of 9 total ships, and 80 aircraft, led by the USS Theodore Roosevelt Aircraft Carrier.

The Group has recently returned from the Gulf, where it conducted 70 escort missions, through 3 security choke points.

The US Navy employs 325,000 men and women, at any given time, 1/3 are deployed, 1/3 are training for deployment, and 1/3 are recently returned from deployment.



After a time as the dominant naval force in the world, the Navy is in the process of “a return to great power competition” with a Russian resurgence, and a China seeking new markets. “Near peer competition.”

In recognition of the importance of maritime commerce to the nation, and safe passage of goods and services, the US is required, by the Constitution to “...maintain a navy...” It is currently facing challenges in the areas of recruitment and retention as the demands of the civilian tech sectors compete for the nation's “best and brightest”. Since 2001 the Navy has reinvented itself as an innovative, agile organization.
